KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Charles Tupper and
 W. M. Estes, of the County of Greenville and
 in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
 Ten (\$10.00) Dollars & other valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by Sandy N. Jones and Addie V. Morris.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said
 Sandy N. Jones, and Addie V. Morris, their heirs
 and assigns forever.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in
 the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid
 on Augusta Street, and having the following metes and
 bounds, Courses and distances: Beginning at corner
 of a brick wall on lot of Mrs. Abbie A. Butler, which point
 being 82' north of the corner of Harris Street, and running
 thence along Augusta Street N. $\frac{3}{4}$ W. sixty-two (62) feet to cor-
 ner of Mrs. Walker's lot, formerly the Whitmire lot; thence
 along said lot N. $\frac{1}{2}$ E. One hundred and twenty feet to
 the rear line, which is line formerly known as lot
 #3 on a plat of the Harris property made by J. W.
 Southern; thence along lot #3 S. 12 E. seventy-eight feet
 to stake on line of lot of Mrs. Abbie A. Butler; thence
 along her lot in a straight line, one hundred and
 thirty-five feet, more or less, to the beginning point
 on Augusta Street. This lot is a portion of lots shown
 on the aforesaid plat of Harris property as numbers
 one and two.

Subject however to the lien of two certain mortgages
 as follows, one executed by N. B. Portman to Mrs.
 Martha L. Lubanks to secure the sum of three
 thousand (\$3,000) Dollars with interest therein provided
 at seven (7%) per cent said mortgage being dated
 August 1, 1919 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greer-
 ville County in Vol. 74 page 315; the other executed by
 Mrs. M. J. Walker to W. A. Wallace to secure the sum
 of two thousand (\$2,000) Dollars with interest therein
 provided at seven (7%) per cent. Said mortgage being
 dated November 10, 1918 and recorded in the R. M. C.
 Office for Greenville County in Vol. 85, page 124,
 which mortgages and mortgage indebtedness the
 grantee herein by accepting this deed expressly
 assumes and promises to pay together with
 interest from dates of execution until paid.

It is understood and agreed that the grantees
 are to pay all taxes for 1920.
