KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, L. H. Stringer and Jno. W.
Greenville by the County and

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by

L. W. Fairis and James J. West

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

L. W. Fairis and James J. West, their heirs and assigns,
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate on
the north side of Pendleton Street in the Fifth Ward of
the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, more
particularly described as follows, to-wit:- Beginning at a
stake on the north side of said Pendleton Street, corner
of lot now or formerly of E. B. Hughes, and running thence
along Pendleton Street North sixty-nine and one-half
(9 1/2) East Twenty (20) feet to a stake corner of lot now or
formerly of Garrett M. Keith; thence along Keith's line
North Eighteen and one-fourth (18 1/4) West one hundred (100)
feet to a stake on a ten (10) foot Alley; thence along said
Alley South sixty-nine and one-half (69 1/2) West Twenty (20)
feet to a stake E. B. Hughes corner; thence along Hughes'
line South Eighteen and one-fourth (18 1/4) East one
hundred (100) feet to the beginning corner, containing two
thousand (2,000) square feet, more or less, and being the
same lot of land conveyed to said L. H. Stringer and
