KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, P. A. Plessley

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Ten dollars, and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Greenville Trust Company,  
in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Greenville Trust Company, its successors and assigns, forever  
all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being  
in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Piedmont Road near  
Oakvale.

Beginning at a rock at the corner of land this day conveyed to C. G. Good, and running thence N. 73° 26. 7. 23 to an iron pin, thence N. 73° 26. 6. 66 to an iron pin, thence N. 66° 1. 22 to an iron pin, thence N. 5½ 26. 1. 88 to an iron pin, thence N. 27° E. 2. 58 to an iron pin, thence N. 37½ 26. 9. 45 to an iron pin, thence S. 59° 26. 4. 12 to an iron pin, thence N. 30° 20' 26. 9. 00 to an iron pin, thence N. 9½ 26. 6. 34 to an iron pin, thence N. 37½ 26. 13. 00 to an iron pin, thence S. 60½ 26. 11. 80 to small sassafrass in a pile of stone, thence S. 62° 26. 34. 10 to an iron staple on the right of way of the C. & G. Railroad, thence along said right of way to the beginning corner, and containing 142  $\frac{15}{16}$  acres more or less.

This deed is made subject to the right of way of the P. & M. Railroad. The tract of land herein conveyed is a part of 208 acres of which the said Thos. J. M<sup>c</sup>Hugh died seized and possessed being the same tract of land conveyed to me, by J. A. M<sup>c</sup>Hugh individually to his trustee, J. P. M<sup>c</sup>Hugh, and Eva Good.
