Eighty Eight and one half (88 1/2) feet to a stake N. C. thence N. 65.00 E. forty (40) feet to a stake N. N., thence N. 20.00 E. Eighty nine and three fourths (89 3/4) feet to a stake N. N. on said street, thence along said street to the beginning corner containing 3560 square feet more or less and being the Western half of the lot of land conveyed to me by Washington Brooks and Minnie Brooks Burton Blake by deed dated Feb. 27th 1919, and recorded in P.
