(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*P. T. Watson, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and
being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about one
mile from the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, Beginning
at a stake on the Western side of Furman Road (sometimes called
Perry Road) at corner of lot #55 in plat hereinafter referred to, and
running thence N. 57-25 W. one hundred ninety four and two tenths
feet with line of said lot #55, to stake in line of lot #46; thence with
line of lots #46 and 47, N. 13-30 E. Sixty one and six tenths feet
to a stake, corner of lot #57; thence with line of lot #57, S. 57-25
E. One hundred four and five tenths feet to stake in said Furman
Road; thence with said Furman Road, S. 20-30 W. Sixty and five
tenths feet to the beginning and herein and designated as
lot #16 in plat of Suburban Land Company's prospecting, recorded
