That for and in consideration of the terms and conditions and the money paid and to be paid, as is hereafter stated, the said Ferguson has bargained and sold and will convey to the said Morris and Blassingame, as is hereinafter stated, All that lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina. Beginning at the intersection of Wardlaw and Birnie Streets and runs thence along the Western side of Wardlaw Street in a southernly direction 235.2 feet, more or less; thence in a Westernly direction 360 feet more or less, to a point on Crook Street 235 feet more or less, from Birnie Street; thence in a northernly direction along Crook Street 235 feet, more or less to Birnie Street; thence in an Easternly direction along Birnie Street 358.8 feet to the beginning corner, subject, however, to a small triangular piece covered by the right-of-way of the C. & G. R.R.

The purchase price for said land Ten Thousand Dollars of which One thousand dollars is this day paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Ferguson and the remainder to be paid on or before the 1st, day of December, 1920, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of Seven per cent per annum, payable annually.
