to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents byLucile Goodwin(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Halene A. Clark

All our right, title and interest in and to all that lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Hampton Avenue Beginning at a stake on Hampton Avenue, corner of lot formerly owned by Robert M. Pickens, and running the distance $7.42\frac{1}{2}$ N. $119\frac{1}{2}$ feet with Hampton Avenue to a stake thence $8.39\frac{1}{2}$ S. 127 feet to a stake thence $850\frac{1}{2}$ E. $119\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake, thence $71.39\frac{1}{2}$ E. 118 to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to Sophie M. Goodwin by D. P. Verner, Master, by deed dated July 15 1904 and recorded in Vol. K.K.R. page 80 and Sophie M. Goodwin has subsequently died leaving all of her property to the said Lucile Goodwin.
