(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said E.D. Hallenberg, J.E. Patton and H.H. Patton,

All that piece parcel or lot of land in the State and County aforesaid, in Greenville Township, in Ward Five, of the City of Greenville on the northeast corner of Hamilton Avenue, and Calhoun Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the northeast intersection of Hamilton Avenue and Calhoun Street and running thence with Hamilton Avenue S. 73. 45 E. Sixty (60) feet to an iron pin corner of lots nos. 14 and 15, thence N. 16-15 E. one hundred seventy-five (175) feet to iron pin on fifteen (15) foot alley thence N. 73-45 W. Sixty (60) feet to iron pin on Calhoun Street thence S. 16-15 W. one hundred seventy-five (175) feet to the point of the beginning.
