WHEREAS, T. E. Green and Asa A. Green

on or about the 26th, day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Tweetie A. Latham, Ida C. Green, Jennie Green Carey, Kathleen Green Glover, Mary Green, Nada Green, Christine Green, Estelle E. Green, Ida E. Green, Bates Green and William Green

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th, day of July 1920, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Asa A. Green

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 7957)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Asa A. Green, his heirs and assigns forever, All the right, title and interest of T. E. Green, Tweetie A. Latham, Ida C. Green, Jennie Green Carey, Kathleen Green Glover, Mary Green, Nada Green, Christine Green, Estelle E. Green, Ida E. Green, Bates Green, and William Green, in and to the following described tract of land: All that certain tract of land in Greenville County, Butler Township, State of South Carolina, about four miles from Greenville City, a part of the Home Place of Abraham Green, deceased, known as tract (No. 2) upon plat of J. N. Southern, dated November 23rd, 1887, on file in Court of Probate, Apartment 47, File 34, described as follows: Beginning at a stone in Edwards Road corner tract No. 1; thence S. 47 E. 4.75 to bend; thence S. 83-15 W. 3.25 to bend; thence S. 54 W. 4.30 to bend; thence S. 34.10 W. to a Spanish Oak 3x; thence N. 80 W. 21.40 to Pile stone 3x; thence N. 57-1/2 W. 6.40 to stone 3x; thence N. 26 W. 1.92 to stake in ditch; thence N. 50 E. 6.20 to white oak gone; stone 3x in Brushy Creek; thence creek the line to mouth branch, corner tract No. 1; thence with line of tract No. 1, S. 31-3/4 E. 41.60 to beginning corner, containing 153 acres, more or less.
