TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Imman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Mollie J. Glenn

on or about the 4th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty (1920) exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Ellison G. Glenn and Grace Glenn Ray

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th day of December 1920, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Imman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to E. Agnew Webster

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Imman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

E. Agnew Webster, his heirs and assigns forever, All the right, title and interest of Grace Glenn Ray in the following described tract of land: All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles from Greenville Court House, lying south of the Laurens Road, containing twenty and one-quarter acres, more or less: Beginning at an iron pipe in a road between tract hereinafter described and McAlister's land and running thence S. 31-30 W. 101.4 feet to a pipe; thence S. 83-15 W. 417.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 93 W. 107.4 feet to a pipe; thence S. 82-15 W. 1042 feet to a stake; thence S. 28-15 W. 297 feet to a stone; thence S. 88 E. 2053 feet to a pipe on the east side of the road; thence with the road 241.8 feet to a pipe; thence running generally with the road N. 45-10 W. 700 feet to the beginning corner; adjoining lands of E. Agnew Webster.

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TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said E. Agnew Webster, his heirs and assigns forever.
