All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Santa Township, adjoining lands of John D. Harris, L. C. Jenkins, Jr., Leonard H. Jenkins and L. C. Jenkins, Jr. and containing 17.50 acres, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on Reedy Fork Creek, on or near the public road and running thence N. 58-50 E. 2.60 chs. to pin in said public road; thence with said road as a line N. 36-15 E. 7 chs. to iron pin; thence still with said road N. 44-38 E. 12.16 chs. to pin corner of L. C. Jenkins, Jr.'s land; thence with his line N. 50-30 W. 6.14 chs. to pin corner of Leonard H. Jenkins's land; thence with his line S. 60-45 N. 16.57 chs. to pin on Reedy Fork Creek; thence with said creek as a line N. 68 chs. to the beginning of corner. Being a portion of the 69 acre tract of land devised to Mary E. Jenkins, et al., by Mary M. Beshenoff.
