All the right, title and interest of the plaintiff and defendants above named, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest, in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the waters of South Saluda River, containing 209 acres, more or less, and bounded as follows: Beginning at a R.O. near J.B.
