WHEREAS, Thomas Buster Wynn

on or about the 24th day of September in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-four exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Hallie Wynn Hester, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of November 1924, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Suman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to C. R. Thompson for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Suman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

C. R. Thompson, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of all the minor Defendants, Mamie Lee Wynn, Rupert Furman Wynn, Mattie Hezel Wynn, Virginia Mae Frances Wynn, Cecil Davis, Hoke Davis, Beulah Davis, Hubert Harold Davis, Boyce Davis, and William Perry Davis in an to the following described tract of land:

"All that certain tract of land situated in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on both sides of the Hunt's Bridge Road, about 7-1/2 miles Westward or north westward from the City of Greenville, and containing 39 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by a plat of same made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, September 16, 1924, to-wit:

Beginning at a stump on corner of land belonging to Mrs. Minnie Wynn and on line of land belonging to Warren Gibson (formerly belonging to Thomas Shockley); thence along the Gibson line S. 11-3/4 W. 38 chains to a stone 3xom on a branch which separates the land herein described from the land now belonging to Bob Williams (formerly belonging to William Wynn); thence up said branch following the meanders thereof as the line 20.34 chains to a stone on line of land belonging to Columbus B. Wynn; thence along his line N. 21 E. 9.90 chains to a stake in the Hunt Bridge Road; thence along said road in a Northwesterly direction (approximately N. 49 W.) 17.50 chains to a stake; thence N. 2-1/4 W. along a small road 3.83 chains to a stake at fork of another road; thence along last mentioned road N. 61-1/2 E. 5.32 chains to a stone on a branch; thence down said branch following the meanders thereof as the line approximately N. 66 W. 2.60 chains to the confluence of another branch; thence up said last named branch (separating the land herein described from land belonging to Mrs. Minnie Wynn), following the meanders thereof as the line approximately as follows: N. 20-1/2 E. 4.35 chains; thence N. 10-3/4 E. 4.00 chains; thence N. 3-1/4 E. 4.50 chains; thence N. 4 W. 3.35 chains to a stake on said branch; thence leaving said branch and running N. 67 W. 4.68 chains to the beginning corner, at the oak stump Kom".

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said C. R. Thompson and his heirs and assigns forever.
