County in the State aforesaid and in Glassy Mountain Township and runs as follows:
Beginning at a stake Rx at the mouth of a ditch thence up said ditch to the branch; thence
with the meanders of said branch in a northerly direction to a Chestnut oak Rx; thence
nearly west a straight line to a Spanish oak Rx; thence nearly northwest to a post oak Rx;
thence nearly south to a Spanish oak Rx; thence nearly north to a pine Rx; thence nearly
southwest to a maple Rx; thence nearly N.E. to a pine Rx; thence nearly East to a chestnut oak
Rx; thence nearly East to a Spanish oak Rx; thence nearly N.E. to a blackgum Rx; thence nearly
South to a Pine Rx; thence nearly S.W. to a stone Rx; thence about west to a stone Rx (at the
