Carpenter, and Mary Ella Carpenter, All that piece parcel and tract or lot of land containing 8544 square feet more or less, situate, lying and being in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, on the North side of Pendleton Street and running the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake 3rd on Pendleton Street corner of the Cox lot, and running thence along said street S. 68 E. 64 ft. to the corner of J. H. Carpenter and C. A. Cook lot, to a stake 3rd 47 feet from the Leach corner thence N. 22 W. 133. 5 ft. with the said Carpenter and Cook line to a stake 3rd thence north 68 west 64 feet to the Cox corner to a stake 3rd thence along the Cox line S. 22 E. 132.5 feet to the beginning corner.
