to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by the said Charles H. Carpenter and Coraelia A. Cook

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Charles H. Carpenter and Coraelia A. Cook, All that piece
of land containing 62.75 square feet,
more or less, situated being in the Fifth
Ward of the City of Greenville in the County and State
aforesaid on the north side of Pendleton Street and
having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Begun
at a stake 34 on Pendleton Street corner of
Carpenter and Leach lots, then with Leach's line N.
22.7 E. 133.5 ft. to a stake 34, thence N. 68.2 W. 47 feet
to a stake 34, thence S. 22.8 E. 133.5 feet to a stake
34 on Pendleton street, thence running on said street
S. 68.2 E. 47 feet to the beginning corner.

The same, being a portion of the lot conveyed
to me by John F. Carpenter by deed bearing date
the 16th of February, 1897 to whom it was conveyed the
3rd of January 1853 by L. M. Watson, and which
was conveyed to said Watson by Varney Mcbee.

The part now being conveyed being the lot
adjacent to the Leach lot facing on Pendleton
Street and next to the lot for which I now decide.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Charles H. Carpenter
and Coraelia A. Cook, their
heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself, my
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Charles H. Carpenter
and Coraelia A. Cook, their
heirs and assigns, forever.

I myself, my
heirs and assigns, against
liars, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
