(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said E. C. Dye: All that certain house and lot in Ward 1, City of Greenville, on the South side of Stark Street and described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of W.C. Harris lot 174, sec 4, office from Rutherford Street on the South side of Stark Street, and running thence with Harris and Elmore back line 115 feet to stake 8 inches in a western direction in a line parallel with Stark 84 feet 8 inches to stake, thence in a northern direction in a line parallel with Harris and Elmore back line 118 feet to stakes on Stark Street, thence with Stark Street in the east direction 84 feet 8 inches to the beginning.

Bridg the same lot, conveyed by Fannie B. (Stone) Clegg to M. S. Ball, May 11, 1920, W.M. C. Bond 64, page 77 and a part of the lot conveyed by W.H. Burgess to Fannie B. Clegg (Stone) December 8, 1910, W.M. C. Bond 9, page 196. Deed D. P. Officer (Married), to W.H. Burgess January 2, 1894, W.M. C. Bond 64, page 750.

As part of the consideration of the said E. C. Dye
Assumed the payment of a certain note and mortgage by M. S. Ball
to Fannie B. Clegg, dated May 11, 1920, due May 11, 1921, with
interest from date, at 7% per cent per annum payable semi-annually
recorded R.M.C. Book 84 page 14. Of the interest which has accrued
up to date upon this note, however, E. C. Dye assumes the
payment, only of \$175.00, the remainder to be paid by M. S. Ball.
It is agreed that the taxes and insurance shall be pro rated
for the year 1920 as of the date of the contract October 16, 1920.
It is further agreed that M. S. Ball shall retain possession
of the premises for a period of E. C. Dye until June 16, 1921, after
which time that M. S. Ball should update the premises prior to that
date he shall be entitled to credit for the unexpired term at the
rate of \$25.00 per month.
