(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *B. F. Hodges et al.* all that certain lot or tract of land, containing 163 acres more or less, situated, lying and being in Pine Mountain Township, State and County aforesaid, on the south side of the Plant Bridge Road and having the following number and boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a point in the north side of Hunt Bridge Road mid summering thence N 36 W. 8. 30 to an iron post, thence S 83 W. 20. 20 to corner of Hunt Bridge Road to iron post, thence S 36 E. 7. 50 to the head of creek, thence S 61 E. 5. 50 to the east pine, thence N 58 E. 18. 30 to the beginning iron post, adjoining tracts 1 and 3. The tract of land herein described is the same as formerly known to L. E. Hodges by Mrs. T. Hodges, Mrs. Anna Davis and J. H.
