at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. P. Atlee*

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. P. Atlee his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the north side of Pendleton Street in the City of Greenville, lying between Hardgrave Street and the C. & L. Railway right of way, and being a portion of lot No. 1 of a subdivision of the lands of Thomas G. Turner, said lot beginning at a point on Pendleton 32.6 feet west of the line of H. G. Strawner's property and running thence 76.12 feet to a stake then back 70.67 feet 30 feet more or less to an alley fence along said alley 8.19¹/₂ E. 6.1 feet to Pendleton Street, thence along Pendleton Street 71.70¹/₂ E. 36 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that the said lot shall have at least 30 feet along Pendleton Street and also any additional feet that might belong thereto by reason of an undetermined width of a certain alley which lies along side of said lot next to and adjoins the old Crescent Grocery Co. building.

It is further understood and agreed that the entire depth of said lot is being conveyed, but the grantor guarantees said lot to a depth of only 96.5 feet instead of 101 feet as above mentioned this being on account of the alley in rear, which is established, will reduce the depth of 4.65 feet.

As a part of the consideration hereinabove mentioned the grantee hereby assumes and promises to pay the following notes, secured by a mortgage covering all or a portion of the above described lot of land.

(1) An unpaid balance of \$1125 on a note executed by S. M. Richardson to W. A. Bates in the sum of \$2250, said mortgage bearing date Sept. 16, 1919 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 79 page 72, together with interest at 6% to \$1125 from Sept. 16, 1920 until paid.

(2) A note secured by a second mortgage, executed by W. D. Workman to S. M. Richardson on Feb. 2, 1920 in the sum of \$1625 together with interest at 6%, from date of execution until paid. J. P. Atlee is to pay all State and County taxes for 1920.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said *J. P. Atlee*, heirs and assigns, forever.
