of a vacant acre in a 10-foot Alley; thence
in a northerly direction forty-four feet due
north and 10 feet west to a stake; thence
in a northerly direction to a stake over 10-foot
alley; thence along said alley forty-three (43) feet
to a stake; thence south toward lot No. 24
forty-five (45) feet; thence in a south westerly direction along
