 All my right title interest and estate in and to the  
 following described tract of land as follows:  
 All the one and undivided interest in that certain piece  
 parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Glassy  
 Mountain in Greenville County and State aforesaid containing  
 one hundred and eighty six acres (186) more or less lying  
 and being on the top of dog back mountain known as the  
 Bamsey Sister tract, being near the lands recently sold by the  
 heirs of the late J. H. Wilcox to R. E. Johnson and near the  
 lands of Joshua Lindsey et al, having the following metes  
 and bounds to wit:  
 Beginning at a forked Chestnut and running thence S. 5° 5'  
 W. 24.00 chains to a hickory, thence S. 15° W. 13.00 chains to a  
 hickory, thence S. 6° E. 20.00 chains to a red oak; thence  
 S. 4.00 E. 3.50 chains to a hickory; thence S. 5.8 E. 4.00 chains  
 to a Red oak; thence N. 7.9 E. 20.00 chains to a Spanish  
 oak; thence N. 4.0 E. 7.00 chains to a pine; thence N. 9 E.
