(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

A. B. Carson and his wife and assigns forever.
 All those lots or parcels of land lying and being situated in the city of Greenville, on the east side of Clifford Street, known and designated as lot no. 10, block of the property of Samuel R. Zimmerman and Terrie M. Zimmerman, a plat of the same having been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County and being more particularly described as follows:

(1) Beginning at an iron pipe on the east side of Clifford Street, corner of lot no. 9 and west said running south 9° 42' - 16 one hundred fifty-nine (159) feet northerly; thence for 48'- one forty-five (6.5) feet to an iron pipe, thence along line of lot no. 10 N. 48'- one hundred fifty-nine (159) feet to an iron pipe on Clifford St., thence along Clifford St. N. 48'- one hundred fifty-nine (159) feet to the beginning corner.

(2) Beginning at an iron pipe on Clifford St., corner of lot no. 6 and no. 7 and running thence along line of lot no. 8, 42'- 05 one hundred fifty-nine (159) feet to an iron pipe, thence N. 45'- one forty-five (6.5) feet to an iron pipe, thence along line of lot no. 5 N. 42'- one hundred fifty-nine (159) feet to an iron pipe on Clifford Street, thence along Clifford Street N. 48'- one hundred fifty-nine (159) feet to the beginning corner.

Subject, however, to the following restrictions, which are a part of the conveyance:

(1) No house shall be built on either of the above lots which costs less than the sum of six thousand dollars.

(2) No house shall be built nearer than twenty feet to the street lines nor nearer than ten feet to the either side line of said lots.

(3) No servants house shall be built on said lots until after dwelling house is built on same lot.

(4) No store building shall be erected on said lots.

(5) Lot to be sold, leased or otherwise disposed of to anyone other than of the Caucasian race.
