(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
 O. M. Scarborough: All that tract, parcel or tract of land situated in Greenville
 County, County of Greenville, South Carolina being a part of Sectional Rail
 Road Company Subdivision, but near Piney Woods,
 having the following bounds: Beginning at corner
 first on Cedar Street, in the right of-way of the Southern Railway
 and running thence N. 61° 15' W. forty-eight (48) feet and five (5) inches to
 an even five (5) feet from Southern Railway and level of Piney Woods
 River, S. 54° 30' W. three hundred and six (306) feet and four
 (4) inches, crossing Richland Creek, to an even front corner of lands of
 Cedar Real Estate and Insurance Co., Mr. White and J. H. Headside
 Farmer, S. 64° 18' crossing Richland Creek again and running eight hundred
 (800) feet to an even point in J. H. Headside's line, thence up the same
 hundred (100) feet to his even front stone in 20.50 W. Two hundred and eighty
 eight (288) feet to an even point in the right of-way of Cedar Street, then
 running around said street in a west and north direction four hundred
