(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mary L. Cox her heirs and assigns, all that piece of land or lot of land situated, lying and being in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, on the South and corner of Perry Avenue and Calhoun Street, and both the following streets and boundaries to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the South East corner of Perry Avenue and Calhoun Street, and running thence S. 18° 54' with Calhoun Street one hundred and forty feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72° 54' seventy-five feet to the iron pin; thence N. 18° E. one hundred and forty feet to an iron pin on Perry Avenue; thence N. 72° 54' seventy-five feet, with Perry Avenue to the beginning corner. Being the same piece of land conveyed to E. E. Clement by Addie R. Caneal by a deed dated Feb. 4, 1920, and recorded in R. M. C. office, Greenville County, Vol. 66 page 557. As in part of the consideration herein above expressed the grantee herein Mary L. Cox, expressly assumes and agrees to pay a certain promissory note executed by E. E. Clement to J. Lee Greene, in the sum of six thousand dollars, dated March 19, 1920, and secured by a mortgage of the above described property, recorded in R. M. C. office, Greenville County, in Vol. 63 page 252. The grantee assumes and promises to pay the said mortgage and mortgage indebtedness, together with interest from May 14, 1920 at seven per cent, payable semi-annually.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Mary L. Cox, Her
heirs and assigns, forever.

AND Mary L. Cox do hereby bind
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said
Mary L. Cox, Her

heirs and assigns, against
Mary L. Cox and
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
