Anderson, all that certain lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the South side of Mill Avenue and being known as aforesaid, and lot No. 10, of Block C of the Eagle Park Addition, and having the following fixtures which bounded it west: Beginning at an iron post on the south side of Mill Avenue, front corner of lots 10 and 11, and running thence N.E. 81-54 E. 25 feet to an iron post on Mill Avenue, thence with line of lots 9 and 10, S. 15-05 E. 158.7 feet to an iron post front corner of lots 9, 10, 7 and 8, thence with the front line of lots 10 and 4, S. 86-03 E. 45 feet, to an iron post front corner of lots 6, 7, 10 and 11, thence with the front line of lots 10 and 11, N. 19-06 W. 155 feet to the beginning point.
