All the right, title or estate of land situate, lying
and bounded in the State of South Carolina, County of
Greenville, City of Greenville, on West Washington
Street, and having for a boundary a public road front
according to a Plat made by C. G. Furman Surveyor
April 15th, 1920, and recorded in Plat Book 6, page 240,
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County,
beginning at a point on West Washington Street, South
east corner of Lot 201 as shown by said Plat, and
running thence with Washington Street 52-48-50 ft. 144
feet to the Southwest corner of Lot No. 8, thence with
