(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. F. Richardson and W. A. Wallace their heirs and  
descendants forever, all those two certain lots or parcels  
of land, lying and being situated in the State and  
County aforesaid, on South Main Street, in the city  
of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots  
nos. 10 and 50 on Plat of Thomas M. Walker Company's  
Subdivision, made August 1919, and laying the fol-  
lowing Metes and Bounds: Beginning at a stake on  
South Main street, at corner of lot no. 11, and running  
thence with line of lots nos. 11 and 29, N. 10-13 W. 14 E.  
jet to Chicora street, thence with Chicora street  
N. 80-15 E. 25 feet to corner of lot no. 24, thence with  
line of lot no. 24 S. 10-12 E. 14 E. 4 feet to South Main St.  
thence with South Main street in a Westerly direction  
25 feet to the beginning corner.

man, August 26, 1919, in the sum of \$1,500.00, and

(4) Mortgage executed by Thomas M. Walker to the  
Board of Trustees of Chicora College, August 26, 1919,  
in the sum of \$2,500.00 said Mortgage being recorded  
in Vol. 53, Page 278. It is understood and agreed
