Austin, his heirs and assigns, all of that lot of land situate on the East side of Brown street, North of North street in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on Brown street and running thence along the rear line of the two lots once owned by Mrs. A. C. Boing, and which fronts North Street 5.686,153 feet to a point on the line of J. F. Hodges (formerly Endel) lot; thence along the line N. 21° E. 45 feet; thence in a straight line 155 feet, more or less, to a point on Brown St. 53 feet and six inches from the beginning corner thence along said street 53 feet, and six inches to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by M. D. Barr, April 1st, 1910, recorded in Vol. 8 page 311.

Also all that other lot of land adjoining the above on the North and described as follows: Beginning at the corner of the M. D. Barr lot on the East side of Brown street and runs therewith the line of that lot about 155 feet to a point in J. F.
