Balentine, all that certain piece of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State, described for the East side of Rutherford Street and having the following mentioned house lot to wit: Beginning at a stake on the southeast corner of Rutherford and Randall streets and running thence along said Rutherford street S. 14° 41' W. 138 feet and 8 inches to a stone on corner of lot conveyed by me to Beulah H. Scwell by deed bearing date April 29, 1919 and recorded in O. R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, there to along line of lot mentioned lot S. 85° 39' E. 206 feet to a stake; thence N. 14° 41' E. 138 feet and 8 inches to a stake on the south side of Randall street thence along said street N. 85° 39' W. 200 feet to the beginning corner known and designated as lots 6 and 7 on the E. Stole to her dated January 5, 1915 and recorded in Vol. 10, page 494 is one and the same person. And I hereby declare that the foregoing statement is true and correct and that I, Frances H. Cushman, am the sole owner of all the said property was intended to be conveyed.
