Ashmore and fully described in that deed in courses and distances and also containing a part of the John Lenderman tract reserved by Louis Cox and deeded to W.S. Moore by Thaddeus Riddle, beginning on poplar at spring; thence S. 79 W. 10 ch. to red oak bush; thence S. 68 W. 6 ch 70 L. to stone on road; thence on said road S. 8 W. 1 ch. 55 L. to Post O; thence on the said line described by Ashmore to L. Cox, containing in all seventy acres, more or less.
