(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. P. Atlee, all that lot or parcel of land situate in Ward Five City of Greenville State and County aforesaid on the West side of Burnet Street, North side of Leach Street, and East side of Bowler Street.

Beginning at the corner of Burnet and Leach streets and running thence with Burnet Street N.W. 30° 30' 251 feet to a point William Hodge's line, thence with William Hodge's line S. 30° 30' 435 feet and 7 inches to Bowler Street, thence S. 59° 30' E. 252 feet to corner of Bowler and Leach Street; thence with Leach Street N. 30° 30' 435 feet and 8 inches to beginning corner of Leach and Burnet Streets. This being the same land conveyed to me by T. H. Painter by deed dated October 19, 1920 and recorded in Vol. 68 page 667.

This conveyance includes a proposed street of 34 feet running from Burnet Street to Bowler Street next to the Hodge's line, but there is no obligation on the part of the grantee to open said street. Excepted from the conveyance, however, is lots 1730 & 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7 of property above described according to plat of this land made by W. D. Rivers and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" page 115. This conveyance includes all the remaining said lot as shown on said plat.

It is understood and agreed that what is known as the Spring Lot included in this area according to said plat is not warranted unto the grantee herein being a small lot of land inclosing the Spring on the corner of said property. This deed is a quiet claim deed to said small portion. Said Spring lot is supposed to be 25 feet square at the northwest corner of lot 15 on Bowler Street.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. P. Atlee, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. P. Atlee, his
