All of that certain piece parcel and tract of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Oaklawn Township, and lying on the waters of Reedy River and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake of Creek Bank, B. F. Holcombe's corner and running thence down said creek as a line 39.00 chs. to fork of creek; thence up the small creek as a line 1.20 chs. to a stake on the creek bank, Owens' Corner; thence with Owens' line N. 48.20 W. 5.74 to a stake 3X; thence N. 84.34 W. 6.90 to a stake; thence N. 53.12 W. 2.51 to a stake 3X; thence N. 41 W. 4.45 to a stake 3X; thence S. 59.74 W. 11.26 to a stone; thence N. 62.40 W. 0.69 to an iron pin 3X; thence S. 38.14 W. 5.75 to an iron pin at road; thence up said road N. 42.12 W. 13.18 to pin 3X; thence N. 57.14 E. 7.86 to an iron pin 3X; thence N. 28.12 E. 19.72 to the beginning corner and containing 57.87 acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by W.
