(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. T. McElvee and J. G. McElvee for life, remainder to the survivor and his heirs and assigns forever a tract of land situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, and adjoining the lands of Sherman McElvee and J. F. Bridgeman and more particularly described as follows: To-wit: Beginning at the northeast corner of Sherman McElvee's land, in the line of the Right of Way of the Southern Railway 50 feet from the center of the track, land running thence with line of Sherman McElvee's land South 40° 50' West 1607 feet to the center of the old Landrum Road, thence with the markers of the center line of the said road in a southeasterly direction 1980 feet to J. F. Bridgeman's corner, thence with Bridgeman's line North 17° 35' E. 1298 feet to the line of the Right of Way of the Southern Railway 50 feet from the center of said track, thence with the line of the Right of Way of the Southern Railway 560 feet to the place of beginning, containing 18 ⁷⁷/₁₀₀ acres.
