T. C. Stone

all of our right, title and interest in and to the following described strips of land situated on Croft and Randall Streets in City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and more particularly described as follows:

1 - Commencing at a point on North side of Croft St. 200 feet from Rutherford St. and running thence in an easterly direction 12 feet; thence in a line parallel with Rutherford St. and in a Northernly direction 200 feet; thence in a line parallel with Croft St. and in a Westernly direction 128 feet; thence in a line parallel with Rutherford St. in a Southernly direction 200 feet to the beginning corner.

2 - Commencing at a point on South side of Randall St. 200 feet from Rutherford St. and running thence with Randall St. in an Easternly direction 12 feet; thence in a line parallel with Rutherford St. in a Southernly direction 200 feet; thence in a line parallel with Rutherford St. and in a Northernly direction 210 feet to the beginning corner.

It being our intention to give our consent for the closing of both ends of a certain alley 12 feet wide extending from Croft St. to Randall St. which appears on plat recorded in Plat Book "A" page 337, but the the grantors herein reserve to themselves, their heirs and assigns, the right to use the space immediately in the rear of their lot which space is 12 feet by 16 feet in order to have ingress and egress from the rear of their lot over and across said space into the 16 foot alley which runs parallel with Croft and Randall Streets; and appear upon said plat. It being distinctly understood and agreed that said strips of land 12 by 16 feet and this 16 foot alley are to forever remain open for the and benefit of the grantors herein, their heirs and assigns, also all other abutting property owners thereon, and the grantors herein by the acceptance of this deed of conveyance agrees thereto.
