to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto C. H. Hayneworth, his heirs and assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward Three of the City of Greenville, on the west side of South Main Street, and having the following notes and bounds, according to a plat thereof made by F.G.-Rogers, on September 7th, 1909:

Beginning at a stake on the west side of South Main Street 117 feet 7 inches southward from the Southwest corner of Main and Broad Streets, and running thence southward along said Main Street 62 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast corner of lot formerly owned by R.N. and J.D. Tannahill; thence turning to the right by an angle of 90 degrees and running westward and parallel with Broad Street along the line of said Tannahill lot 170 feet to a stake on the Northwest corner of said Tannahill lot and on the East side of an alley 11 feet 3 inches wide, which opens into Merkley alley on the South; thence turning to the right by an angle of 90 degrees and running along the East side of the alley first above mentioned and parallel with Main Street 62 feet to an iron pin on the corner of said alley and another alley which opens into Jackson Street; thence turning to the right by an angle of 90 degrees and running Eastward and parallel with Broad Street along the South side of alley last mentioned and along the South side of the lot of S.E. Bradshaw, et al. 170 feet to the beginning corner on Main Street. This being the same lot of land conveyed to Greenville Realty & Investment Company by William M. Barnwell, December 29th, 1924.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay a first mortgage covering the above described property, executed January 2nd, 1925, by Greenville Realty & Investment Company, to C.H. McGee, in the sum of \$60,000.00, payable five years after date thereof, bearing interest at the rate of six per cent. from date, payable semi-annually; and a second mortgage covering the above described property, executed January 2nd, 1925, by Greenville Realty & Investment Company to W.M. Barnwell, in the sum of \$18,500.00, payable three years after date, and bearing interest at the rate of six per cent. from date, payable semi-annually. The first mortgage hereinabove referred to is recorded in the R.M.C. And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
