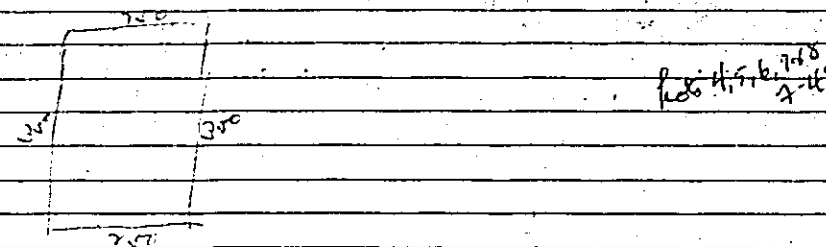

John A. Russell, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, on the Esley Bridge Road and known as a portion of the Earle Property and being a portion of the lands conveyed to me by T.O. Turner by deed dated March 3, 1922, recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 79 at page 286, this property herein conveyed, beginning at a point on the White Horse Road 150 feet in a northwesterly direction from the southeast corner of the property conveyed to me in the foregoing deed, and running thence along said White Horse Road N. 22 W. 250 feet to corner on said Road; thence S. 68 W. 350 feet to the back line of my property; thence running along said back line S. 22 E. 250 feet to corner on my property; thence N. 66 E. 350 feet to the beginning corner.

Viola M. Baker, and her heirs and assigns, All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. eleven (11) on a plat made by William A. Hudson, dated November 29, 1901 and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book A., at page 163, showing the land sold by J.W. Howell to W.H. Irvine, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the South side of Dunbar Street, on the north-east corner of lot No. 10, on said plat, being approximately five hundred and eighty-eight (588) feet eastward from Frank Hammond's original corner, and running thence S. 18° W. two hundred and fifteen (215) feet along line of lot No. 10 to a stake; thence S. 76° E. fifty (50) feet to a stake on the South-west corner of lot No. 12; thence with line or last mentioned lot N. 18° E. two hundred and fifteen (215) feet to a stake on Dunbar Street; thence along said Street N. 76° W. fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner.
