Mt. Pleasant Church, Miss Lora, Estate of Walter M. Scott deceased and White Horse Road, in Parttt Township and being all the land owned by G. P. Rogers, my deceased father

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires, and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.
