at and before the sealing of these presents by *John C. Pruitt*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John C. Pruitt, his heirs and assigns forever.

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, on the south side of West Washington Street being known and designated upon a plat of same made by R. C. Dillon Engineer, on October, 1920, as Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and the northern portion of Lot No. 6, being that portion of said Lot No. 6 not heretofore conveyed to the same John C. Pruitt Company, and being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of West Washington Street being the northeastern corner of Lot No. 1, and running thence with said street along lines of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7 and 9, 77.47-44 2/106 feet to a point on said street being the northeastern corner of Lot No. 9, thence S 42-30 W 75 feet to a point on alley, thence S 46-32 W 72.9 feet along rear line of Lot 9, 87 and 6 to point on line of Lot No. 5, thence S 42-30 W 86.9 feet to point on 15-foot alley, being corner of Lot 5 and lots heretofore conveyed to said same John C. Pruitt Company, thence along said alley S 46-32 E 105 feet to point on said alley, southeast corner of Lot No. 1, thence leaving said alley and running N 42-30 E 162.5 feet to iron pin, on Washington Street, the beginning corner, this being a portion of the property conveyed to me by George W. Taylor, by deed dated November 11th 1919.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantee herein does hereby assume and agree to pay the sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred (\$5,000) Dollars being a portion of a debt of Fifteen (\$15,000) Thousand Dollars, given by W. D. Workman to the estate of Mrs. W. Taylor, said secured by a mortgage covering the described property, said assumption and payment to be made by grantee according to the terms and conditions of said note and mortgage, excepting that the grantee herein is to assume interest upon said indebtedness from the date of this deed.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said...
