and other considerations

to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Jno. Y. & M.B. Taylor

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Jno. Y. & M.B. Taylor: A one-twelfth interest in the following described property, and being a part of the remaining one-fourth interest owned by C.P. Armstrong in the real estate owned jointly by the firm of Armstrong & Taylor, and deeded to W.B. Stewart by C.P. Armstrong Nov. 24th, 1919.

"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate on the South side of Main Street in the Town of Fountain Inn, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, bounded by Main Street, D.M. Garrett, Alley and Mrs. L.P. Armstrong; Beginning at an iron pin on D.M. Garrett's corner on Main Street, and running thence S. 53-1/2 W. 161-2 feet to alley; thence along said alley N. 36-3/4 W. 68 feet to a point in alley; thence N. 53-1/2 E. 161-2 feet to a point on Main Street, thirteen inches above the corner of Mrs. L.P. Armstrong's brick building; thence S. 36-3/4 E. 68 feet to beginning corner, and being the same conveyed to J.Y. Taylor and C.P. Armstrong by J.W. Fowler".

Also
"All that other certain lot or parcel of land in the Town of Fountain Inn, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, and being the same conveyed to Armstrong & Taylor Company by J.A. Adams by his deed recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Vol. 4, at page 63. Said lot now being known as the Warehouse Lot, of Armstrong & Taylor, and lying upon the C. & W.C. Railway; Commencing at an iron pin at the corner of property formerly belonging to L.P. Armstrong and known as Stable Property, and running thence with Armstrong's line 109 feet to back on C. & W.C. R.R.; thence N. 61-2 W. 34 feet to an iron pin on corner of property formerly belonging to J.W. Givens; thence with Givens property N. 52-3/4 E. 122 feet to an iron pin; thence 37-2 E. 33 feet to beginning corner".

Also
Those two lots of land near the town of Fountain Inn in Laurens County, bounded by B.F. Gault, L.M. Nash and two new streets, being a portion of the land bought by W.B. Stewart and H.L. Shaw from J.Q. Cannon, and being all of the real estate owned by the firm of Armstrong & Taylor, in said County & State.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Jno. Y. & M.B. Taylor, and their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself and my do hereby bind heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Jno. Y. & M.B. Taylor, and their heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
