On the East side of East Bridge Road and having the following corners and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Looper's line, corner of Tract nos. 68 and 7, and running thence N. 47 E. 4.50 to a pin corner of Tract no. 5, thence along line of Tract no. 5 N. 47 E. 8.60 to a pin on an unmarked 20 foot road, thence along said road N. 43 W. 5.60 to a pin corner of tract no. 8, thence along line of Tract N. 10.8 S. 47 W. 8.30 to a pin on Looper's line, thence along Looper's line S. 31 1/2 E. 2.50 to a heel in said line, thence continuing along Looper's line S. 4 1/2 E. 3.00 to the beginning corner and being known and designated as Tract no. 7 of the Plat of Mellic Rosemond property made by G.
