In the City of Greenville, being a strip of land forty feet wide extending from the north side of Eagle street to the south side of Broad street, known as Whitehall street on a plat of stone land Company recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book #, page 337.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by on the day of 1925, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Book Page. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
