Beginning at a stone, corner of Minner Lee Farm's lot No. 2 and running thence N. 80-00 W. 9.00 Chains to a stone, S. m. Campbell's corner; thence N. 4-0-0 E. 20.06 Chains to a stone O. m. E. B. Barnett's corner; thence S. 76-15 E. 14.00 to a branch; thence up said branch about 85 links to a stone on the east side; thence N. 76-15 W. 3.00 Chaining to a stone N. m.; thence S. 10-0-0 W. 19.00 Chaining to beginning containing twenty (20) acres more or less, according to a survey and plat made by W.
