to Ellyatt A. Ricks,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Ellyatt A. Ricks,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville County State of South Carolina,

situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, bounded first, being the property of Standard Oil Co., the Southern Railway, and Chattooga and Bessey, Inc., and being more fully described as follows:

Bounding at an corner from the said oil, at the S. E. corner of property of Standard Oil Company, and running thence with line of Standard Oil Co. property S. 81-6 E. 368.6 feet to another piece, corner of Standard Oil and Southern Ry. property; thence along the property of the Southern Ry. S. W. 47-8 W. 99.3 feet to another piece, corner of the described property; S. AND we do hereby bind ourselves as Trustees, but successively and severally, heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H. W. D. Allens and G. F. Gaskins, his

heirs and assigns, against successors and trustees, but successively and severally, and every other person whom lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
