on the west side of Summit Drive, known and designated as a portion of tract No. 1 of Concord Farm, according to a plat of said Concord Farm recorded in the R. M. G. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 552, and having the following lines and bounds: to west, beginning at an iron stake on the west side of Summit Drive, at joint corner of tract nos. 2 and 3, thence with joint line of tract 2 and 3 N. 89-54 W. 794.5 feet to corner of lot theretofore conveyed to G. A. Ellis to D. Bridges (see deed recorded in Vol. 57, page 6-22, R. M.
