All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Butler Township, on the West side of Lindsay Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 14 of the property belonging to Congers, Bowler and Parish, and having, according to a survey made May, 1928, by Dalton and others, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at a point on the West side of Lindsay Avenue, which point is 170 feet South of the intersection of Lindsay Avenue with the Bowlers Hill Road, and running thence S. 81-02 E. 220.1 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 55-45 E. 240.4 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Lindsay Avenue, which iron pin is 480 feet North of the intersection of Lindsay Avenue with the Bowlers Hill Road, and running thence with the West side of Lindsay Avenue, N. 61-0.90 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the West side of said Avenue, N. 9-14 E. 89.5 feet to the point of beginning.

As part of the consideration for the foregoing conveyance, the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the mortgage in the sum of Forty Four Hundred Fifty Eight (\$4,458.00) dollars given by Mr. G.
