in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said C. A. Farnester his heirs and assigns:

A one-half interest in
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County State of South Carolina.

Near Swamp mill, containing one Hundred and Five (105) Acres, more or less, according to a survey made by Charles C. Rogers on Sept. 9th, 1903, with the following lines:
