All right, title and interest in and to that certain lot of land situate, lying and being on the south side of Ann Street, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known as lot No. 1 on plat of property belonging to the Estate of Henry Campbell, deceased, made by R. E. Walton, Engineer, March 1930, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County; said lot being more particularly described on said plat as follows:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Ann Street, the Northwest corner of lot No. 2, and running thence with said Ann Street, S. 77-0 W. 53-3 feet to an iron pin in line of property of Mrs. Williams; thence S. 12-25 E. 64 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 77-0 E. 33-3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-25 E. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 77-0 E. 20 feet to an iron pin, the Southwest corner of lot No. 2; thence in a northerly direction 119 feet to the beginning corner on Ann Street.
