All that certain piece, Parcel or lot of ground in Gravel and Cemetery, Greenville County, State of Carolina, designated by lot #360, Section 5, containing 200 square feet, more or less; the same being described and designated as above, in accordance with map on file in the office of said Corporation.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by _____ on the _____ day of September 1928, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Book _____, Page _____.
 TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville Cemetery Association, its heirs and assigns forever.

AND to hereby bind warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said heirs, executors and administrators to

person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
