 W. T. Henderson his heirs and assigns forever,  
 all of that certain tract, parcel or lot of land together  
 with the buildings thereon, on the south side of  
 West Cope Street, between Lawrence and Richardson  
 Street, and having the following metes and bounds  
 and further description: Beginning at a point in  
 the south side of West Cope Street, which point is  
 eighty seven (87) feet and 6 inches west of the south  
 west corner of Cope and Lawrence Streets and running  
 thence with West Cope Street twenty six (26) feet  
 and three and one-half (3 1/2) inches to a point which  
 is at the center of the end of a brick wall dividing  
 the property purchased by the said J. C. Redmon  
 from G. L. Gitterell as shown by a plat made  
 in G. L. Gitterell's Book December 1919, thence S. 22-19 E.  
 with the outer of said wall eighty-eight (88) feet
