Beguning at a point in center of old Anderson
Road, and New Anderson Road, where the center of
both roads meet, about 140 feet from the center of
Branches lesser, running a rod or so that lot conveyed
from west to the tract in Judson Miller, there with
this corner, is the new road, northwesterly to a point
at the center of the old and new roads, where the
old and new roads meet with the center of the old
road bush-westerly to the beginning corner, being
all of that part of the tract so hard conveyed to
